Dr. Neel is the Director of the Laura and Isaac Perlmutter Cancer Center and Professor of Medicine at NYU Langone Health in New York City. Dr. Neel's research focuses on cellular signaling, with a particular interest in the biology and regulation of protein-tyrosine kinases and -phosphatases, the role of RAS/ERK pathway mutations in developmental disease and malignancy, and the biology of breast and ovarian cancer. His graduate work on oncogene activation by slowly transforming RNA tumor viruses had major impact on the field. He has received numerous awards and is the co-founder of Northern Biologics, a company focusing on antibody therapeutics for cancer and fibrosis.
